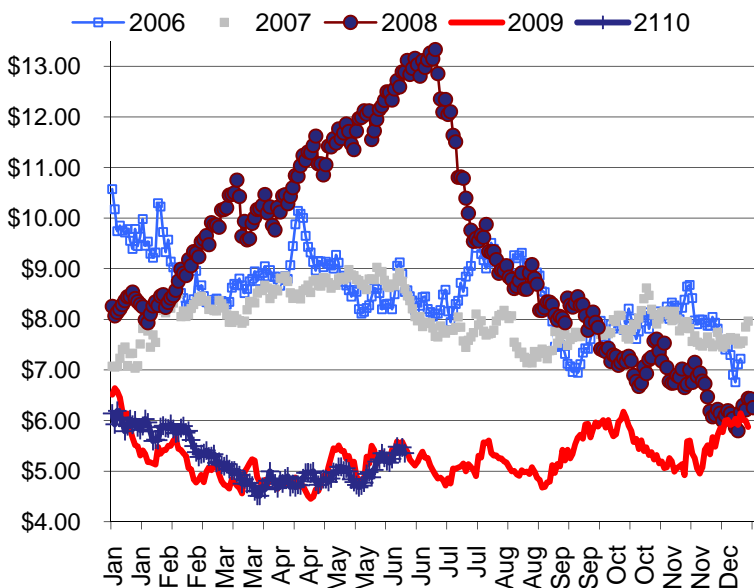

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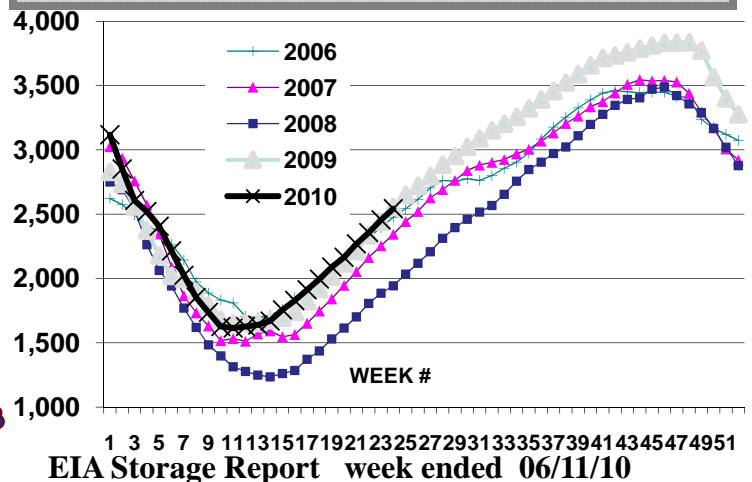
ON THE NYMEX MARKET

We were up and down last week but landed in about the same place. The NYMEX 12 month strip has been following the same path as last year. Take a look at the chart below. In order for that to continue we need the forecast to cool off. The other driver is the weekly storage injections. This week the storage was 3 bcf under the markets expectations and the market jumped 18 cents. The fact is storage this year is still 11 bcf above last year's record high levels and 14 percent above the 5 year average. Storage comparisons to last year have been difficult. Last year the past eight weeks averaged 102 bcf each week. The rest of last year's storage season average was close to 60 bcf. After next week we should see much better comparisons. The bullish news is the extended warmer-than-normal weather forecast and the active hurricane season. Hurricane season started in June but the most active period starts in late August.

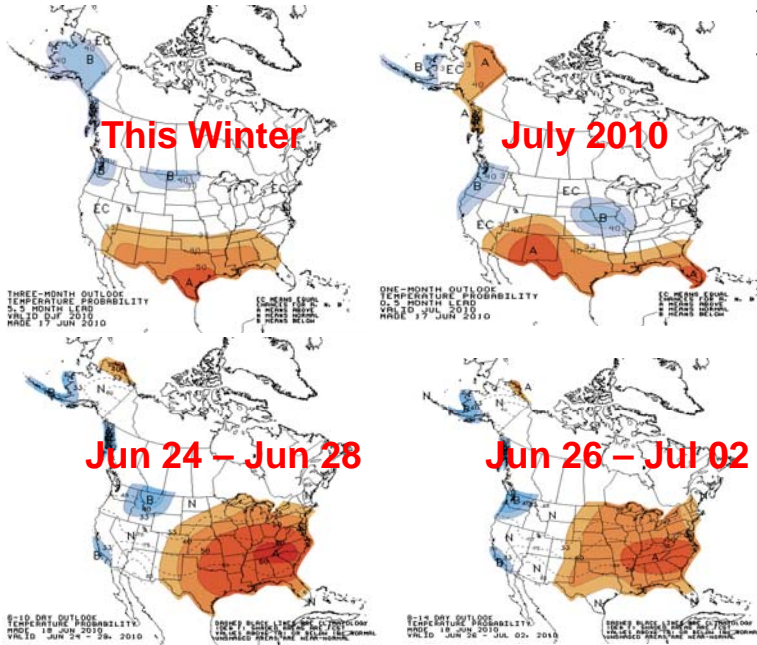
Gas in Storage



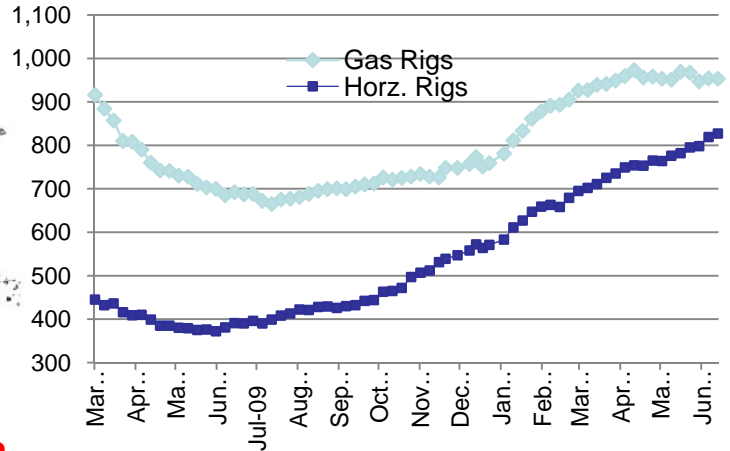

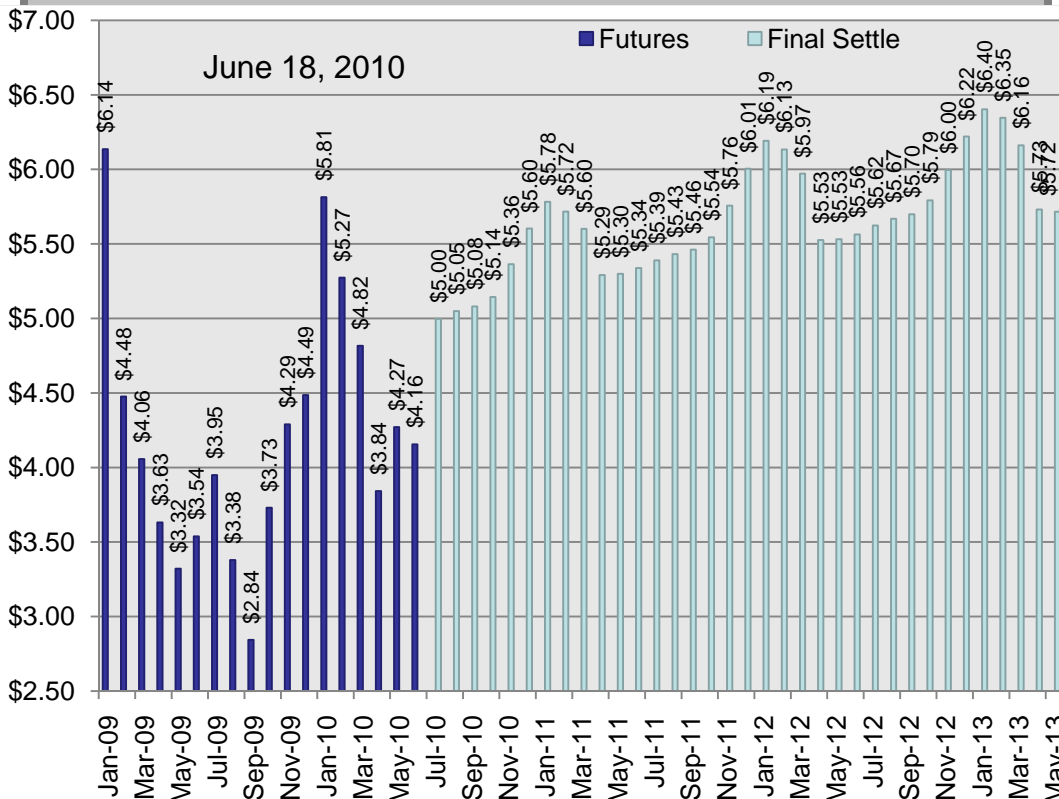


Rig Count
