



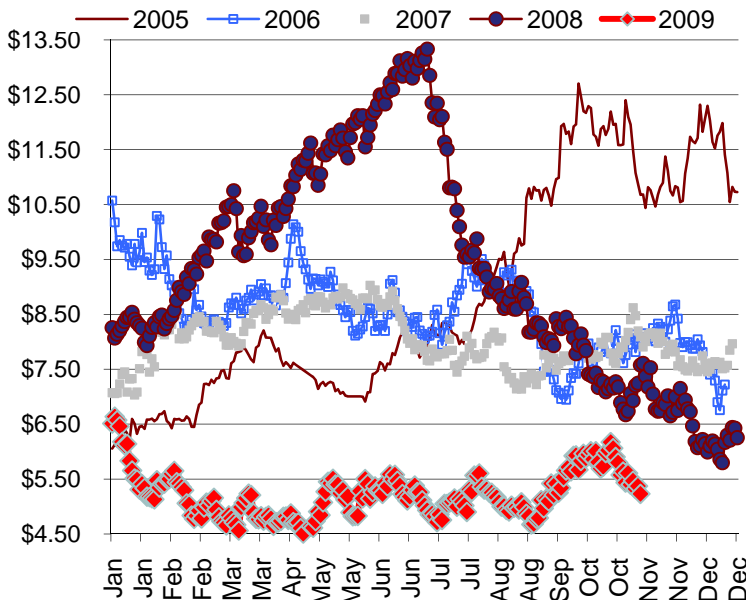

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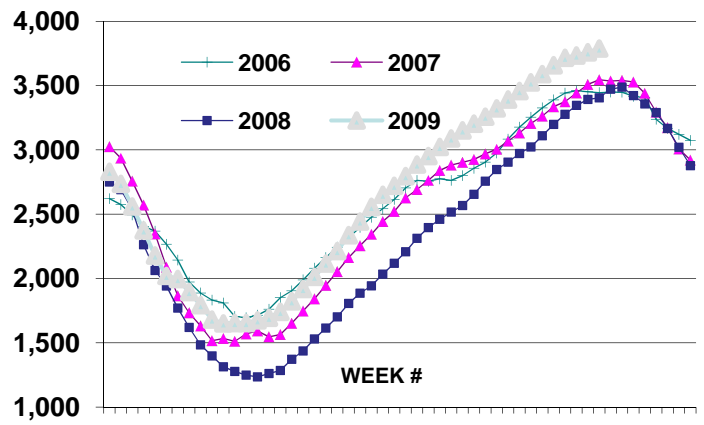
ON THE NYMEX MARKET

The December NG contract is down about \$1 in the last 11 trading days. It is very difficult to sell NG when you have weak industrial demand and forecasts of moderate temperatures in the major gas consuming regions over the next two weeks. Unfortunately many more factors effect the cost of NG today than in the past. The U.S. unemployment shot to its highest level in more than 26 years, rising 0.4 percentage point to 10.2%, according to the Labor Department. Demand for NG may be slow in recovering. The weak jobs number may mean more economic stimulus, and with the Federal Reserve's decision this week to keep interest rates low, it will keep the dollar under pressure. Traders can borrow dollars at very low interest rates (near zero), purchase crude oil or NG which may increase in value and then repay the loan down the road with cheaper dollars. This is just one of the many factors in the energy market today.

Gas in Storage

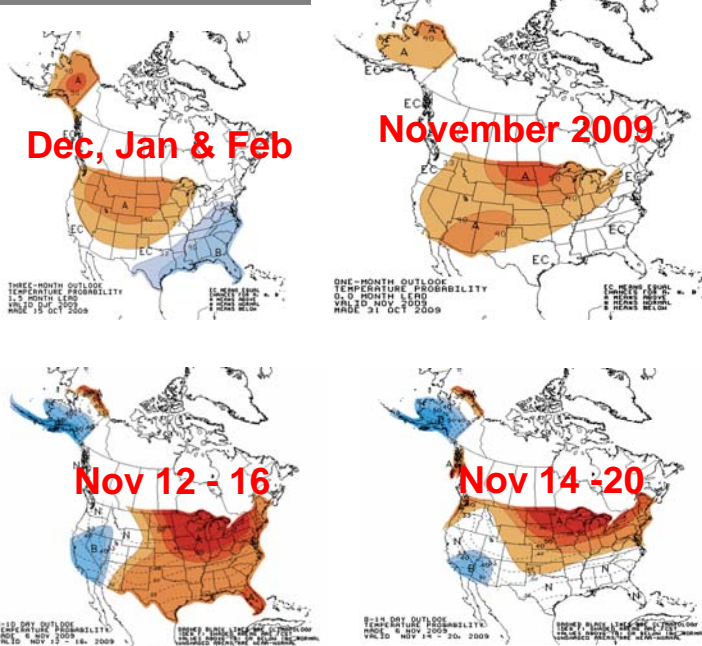

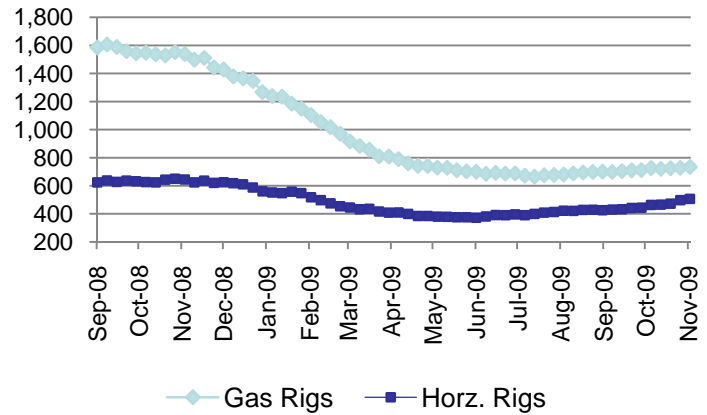

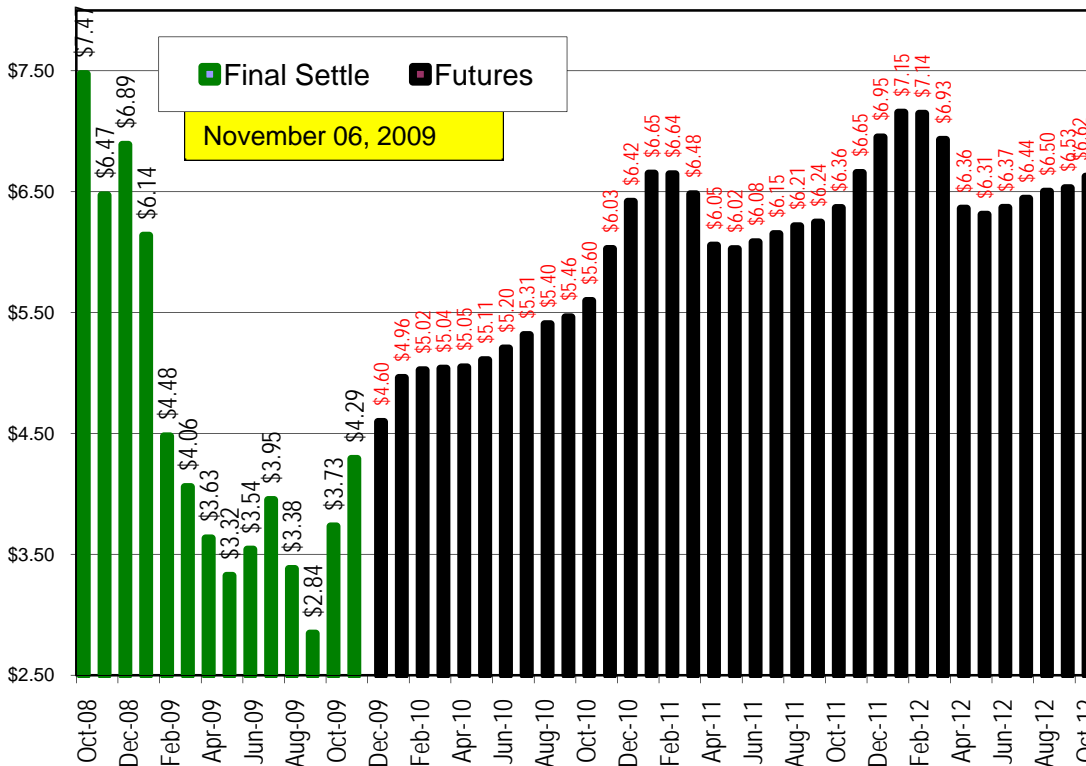


Rig Count
